

Kristin Adrian is the General Counsel and Chief Compliance Officer of American Realty Advisors, an investment advisor registered with the Securities Exchange Commission, with in excess of \$8.2 billion of commercial real estate assets under its management. She is responsible for overseeing all legal and compliance issues within the firm, including compliance with the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, with the Employee Retirement Income Securities Act of 1974, and with the firm's policies and procedures. She is also responsible for overseeing legal issues related to the firm's operations and the commingled funds sponsored by ARA, for the firm's SEC filings, its business recovery plan, its records retention program, and for engaging and oversight of outside counsel.

Ms. Adrian is a member and past chair of the Executive Committee of the Corporate Law Departments Section of the Los Angeles County Bar Association and has been elected to the Board of Trustees of the Association.

Ms. Adrian has served as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Los Angeles County Bar Association since July 1, 2017 and was recently appointed as Assistant Vice President of the Executive Committee. She is a prior Chair of the Corporate Law Departments Section of the LACBA.
