**Los Angeles County Bar Association Releases Voting Results
9.98 Percent of Eligible Voters Cast Ballots in the Vote for President-Elect**

Ann I. Park will become President-Elect for the 2021-22 bar year. As President-Elect, Ms. Park will automatically ascend to the position of LACBA President.

Los Angeles, California – June 3, 2021 – The Los Angeles County Bar Association (LACBA) announced that 9.98 percent, or 1,580 of 15,828 eligible members, voted in the 2021 contested election for President-Elect. The election concluded on Tuesday, June 1, 2021, at 11:59 p.m.

Jensen, LACBA’s President. “The two candidates engaged in a vigorous debate these last several months, and our members have chosen Ann to be our next President-Elect.
