### [Shattuck-Price Outstanding Lawyer Award](#)

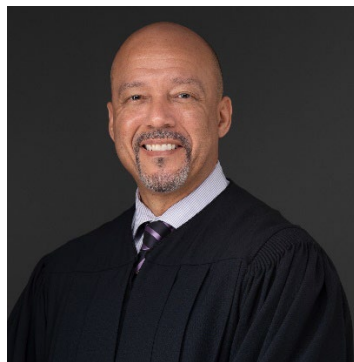
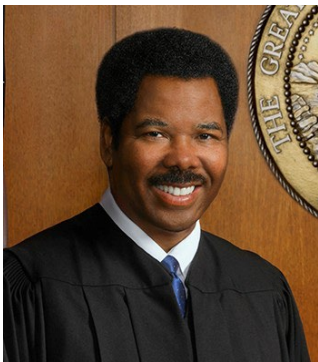

### [Outstanding Jurist Award](#)

In a break from tradition and previous years, two recipients received the 2022 Outstanding Jurist Award. Los Angeles Superior Court Judges, the Honorable Kevin C. Brazile and the Presiding Judge Eric C. Taylor, were selected based on their joint leadership of the court system during the pandemic. Judge Kevin C. Brazile was appointed to the Superior Court of Los Angeles County bench in 2002 and served as presiding judge from 2019-2021. Judge Taylor has served the Los Angeles Superior and Municipal Courts for 21 years. He served as Assistant Presiding Judge in 2018 and has been the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court since January 1, 2021.
